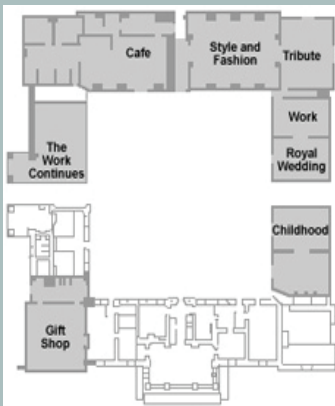


## CORNERSTONE BUILDING CONSERVATION

# Althorp Hall Princess Diana Exhibition



On 31st August 1997 the Princess of Wales, Lady Diana Spencer, was killed in a car crash in Paris.

In 1999 her brother Charles Spencer commissioned a team of Architects and specialist contractors to turn the stable block at Althorp into an exhibition space to celebrate the life of his sister.

The Buildings date back to 1772-1773 and are of historic importance. The Brief was to 'insert' the workings of a modern exhibition space within a confined and delicate environment.

Cornerstone undertook, stone repairs, plaster repairs and specialist conservation repairs throughout the building with special interest in the cleaning and matching of brick specials in the stable floor, making suitable replacements by hand
