In 2003 senior managers at Cornerstone were asked to provide a team of conservators, specialist plasterers and decorators for the repair and conservation of Staircase House, Stockport.

The building was in a derelict state and had on several occasions been on fire. The main body of the building consisted of a timber frame core with wattle and daub/plaster infill panels.

The works consisted of a preliminary survey carried out together with the architect, then a written report from which the schedule of conservation and repair was built.

The work was completed in 2004 and has since been submitted for several awards
